

AUSA Registration Agreement

BETWEEN

The Adelaide University Student Association Inc ABN 26 226 387 970
of 108 North Terrace, Adelaide in the State of South Australia 5005 (“AUSA”)

AND

The Party (“the Club”) named in Section 13

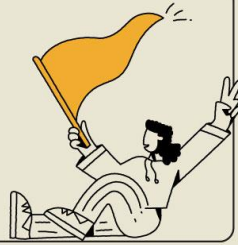
1. Definitions

1.1. In this Agreement:

- a. **Adelaide University** or **University** means Adelaide University.
- b. **AU Policies** means all policies, procedures, directions, bylaws, guidelines and codes of conduct of the University, as amended from time to time.
- c. **Club Activity** means any activity conducted by or on behalf of the Club, including stalls, meetings, events, protests, or use of University facilities.
- d. **Transitional Registration** means the temporary registration status granted under clause 2.
- e. **University Marks** means the University name, logo, branding, official insignia and other intellectual property of the University and includes all names, and logos, branding and official insignia of The University of Adelaide and the University of South Australia.

2. Transitional Registration

- 2.1. From 1 January 2026, AUSA grants the Club automatic Transitional Registration if the Club was previously affiliated with USASA or YouX.
- 2.2. Transitional Registration provides the Club with the rights and entitlements of a registered AUSA club, subject to the terms of this Agreement.
- 2.3. Transitional Registration will expire on 30 June 2026, unless the Club successfully registers with AUSA by that date.
- 2.4. Failure by the Club to register with AUSA by 30 June 2026 will result in automatic cessation on 30 June 2026 of:
 - a. the registration of the Club with, and recognition of the Club by, AUSA; and
 - b. all privileges of registration with AUSA including all rights granted to the Club under this Agreement, as set out in clause 10.



3. Permitted Use During Transitional Registration

- 3.1. While holding Transitional Registration, the Club may:
 - a. continue to use its existing name, constitution, and marketing materials that contain or refer to a name or logo of The University of Adelaide or the University of South Australia; and
 - b. exercise the additional rights and entitlements agreed between AUSA and the University and set out in this Agreement.
- 3.2. The Club must not create or distribute any new materials using any name or logo of The University of Adelaide or the University of South Australia during the Transitional Registration period.

4. Privileges of Registration with AUSA

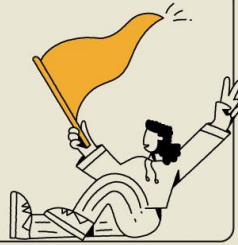
- 4.1. Subject to this Agreement, a Club that is registered with AUSA is entitled to the rights and entitlements facilitated by the University as described below.

5. Use of University Name and Logo

- 5.1. The Club must not include “Adelaide University” in the Club’s name, unless the University (or AUSA on behalf of the University) has provided permission to the Club to use the Adelaide University name, and subject to the University (or AUSA on behalf of the University) revoking this permission.
- 5.2. The Club must not acknowledge, display, use, publish or otherwise refer to or use (including in any marketing material or signage) any AU Marks, excluding, where applicable (subject to paragraph (5.1) above), in the use of their full Club name.
- 5.3. The Club must have a mission and values that align with the mission and values of the University.
- 5.4. The Club must ensure that its committee and members comply with all University Brand Guidelines.

6. Compliance with AUSA Policies

- 6.1. The Club and its management committee must comply with the AUSA Clubs Code of Conduct and all AUSA Policies and procedures (including those relating to confidentiality, privacy and cyber security, behaviour and conduct, and gender-based violence), and must use reasonable endeavours to ensure all Club members do the same.
- 6.2. The Club must take appropriate action to address conduct by members or participants in Club Activities and that breaches AUSA Policies and the AUSA Clubs Code of Conduct.



- 6.3. Breaches of AUSA policies will be handled according to the AUSA Clubs Code of Conduct and related procedures.
- 6.4. If the Club becomes aware of, reasonable suspects, or believes that a breach of AUSA policies has occurred or may occur, the Club must notify AUSA in accordance with the AUSA Clubs Code of Conduct and AUSA Clubs Disciplinary and Grievance Procedure.

7. Compliance with University Policies

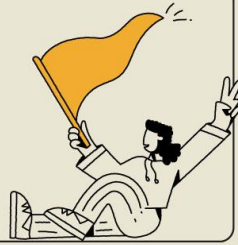
- 7.1. The Club and its management committee must comply with all AU Policies and must use reasonable endeavours to ensure all Club members do the same.
- 7.2. The Club must take appropriate action to address conduct by members or participants in Club Activities that breaches AU Policies.
- 7.3. Breaches of AU Policies may result in:
 - a. temporary or permanent de-registration of the Club by AUSA;
 - b. disciplinary action against student members under University policies; and
 - c. management of staff members under applicable University agreements and policies.
- 7.4. If the Club becomes aware of, reasonably suspects, or believes that a breach of AU Policies has occurred or may occur, the Club must notify AUSA and the University in writing within 7 days.

8. Use of University Facilities

- 8.1. The Club must obtain prior written approval from the University before conducting any Club Activity on University campuses or using University facilities.
- 8.2. All Club Activities must be conducted in compliance with applicable AU Policies, and terms and conditions for use of University facilities.
- 8.3. The Club must comply with all applicable AUSA policies and procedures, including the AUSA Clubs Facility Use Policy.
- 8.4. The Club acknowledges that University booking policies for use of University campuses and/or facilities may change from time to time.

9. Insurance

- 9.1. Subject to policy terms, exclusions, and conditions, the Club is covered under the University's insurance arrangements administered through AUSA, including:



- a. personal accident;
 - b. Business Travel for flights booked in accordance with AU policies and procedures;
 - c. public liability; and
 - d. professional indemnity
- 9.2. The Club acknowledges and agrees that coverage under the University's insurance applies only where Club Activities:
- a. comply with AU Policies and AUSA requirements; and
 - b. are consistent with the Club's recognised objectives.
- 9.3. Activities that fall outside these requirements may not be insured and are undertaken at the Club's sole risk.
- 9.4. The Club acknowledges and agrees that the Club and its members will not be entitled to claim under University insurances for loss arising from serious misconduct or wilful misconduct of the Club or the member.
- 9.5. If the Club believes an activity may not be covered by University insurance, it must notify the University as soon as reasonably practicable.
- 9.6. During the term of Insurance, Clubs must:
- a. provide written notice as soon as practicable to AUSA and the University of any insurance claim or notifiable event, or potential notifiable event, under insurances covering the club and its activities of which it becomes aware;
 - b. provide AUSA and the University with such information as AUSA and the University may request from the Club from time to time for the purposes of or in connection with the Relevant Insurances and / or renewal of the Relevant Insurances;
 - c. participate as required by the University in AU's annual insurance declaration and renewal process;
 - d. provide all reasonable assistance as requested by the University's Insurance Office or insurers from time to time for or in connection with the Relevant Insurances; and
 - e. comply with all University Instructions and AU Policies applicable to the Relevant Insurances and the Club as an insured.



10. Cessation of Rights

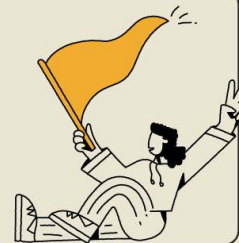
- 10.1. If the Club ceases to be registered with AUSA for any reason:
- a. the Club will immediately cease to be recognised as a University club;
 - b. all rights and entitlements under this Agreement will immediately terminate;
and
 - c. the Club must immediately cease using the University Marks and remove them from all Club materials, including destroying materials where necessary.

11. Notices

12. General

- 12.1. This Agreement does not create a partnership, agency, or employment relationship between the parties.
- 12.2. This Agreement is governed by the laws of South Australia.
- 12.3. AUSA may update requirements consistent with University policies and its own policies from time to time.
